The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) requires that if an employer that participates in group rating or group retrospective rating plan sustains a claim within the "green year" period or the prior year, the employer needs to attend an additional two hours of safety training annually. The timely completion of this training is mandatory in order to maintain an employer's group rating status.

Alcohol Compliance Awareness Training, OSHA 10 Hour Compliance, and Workplace Violence Awareness Training.
