



## Urgent! News You Can Use 15K Participants

In December 2007, Congress approved Section 111 of the Medicare, Medicaid and SCHIP Extension Act. This Act addresses payment of benefits, specifically, when Medicare is the secondary payer for these benefits. Medicare has been a secondary payer for workers' compensation benefit payments since the inception of the Medicare program in 1965. Therefore, in order to avoid duplicate payments for the same services, this Act establishes mandatory reporting requirements which impacts workers' compensation plans and any benefits paid.

The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) will report the benefits paid through the state system to Medicare beneficiaries. However, **because your company participates in the Fifteen Thousand Medical Only Program and is paying medical benefits, you are also required to file these reports.**

**THE REGISTRATION DATE HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2009 WITH THE REPORTING BEGINNING APRIL 2010 WITH QUARTERLY UPDATES THEREAFTER.** All entities must file reports electronically in the format dictated by CMS and include minimum data requirements.
